Remarks: As well as the above syllabus, the test includes students' prior knowledge.

Important Notes:

1. During the exam period, class times will remain the same, and dismissal time from 12th March to 18th March will be at 12:50p.m.
2. Students should remember to bring sufficient stationery.
3. Students who are late for the tests **will not be given any extra time** except in exceptional circumstances and approved by the school.
4. Students who are absent from test due to any circumstances must take the make-up test on the first day of returning to school and complete it on or before 20th March. Students who are absent from test due to sickness must provide **medical certificates** and the score will be calculated at 100%. If you are absent due to personal leave, you must provide a **school leave letter** and if it is approved by the school, the score will be calculated at 80%. No make-up test will be arranged on the third school day after the exam.
5. To ensure fairness in examination system, parents and students should not discuss test questions with other parents and students until the make-up test is completed.
6. If a student cheats on exam, the school will strictly handle it. For example, the student may get a mark deduction, a grade cancellation, or a demerit.

Other arrangements during exam period:

1. The class dates for the homework tutorial class can be found in the reminders in the handbook.
2. After-school tutorial classes will continue as normal.
